

Infection control rules and measures in TK exams at ICETRA

- Students will enter through a special entrance.
- Students will be admitted in alphabetical order at the start of each exam. A 2 meter separation between students shall be maintained if a queue forms.
- A close gathering of students is strictly prohibited outside the exam room on ICETRA's premises.
- The use of hand sanitizers is mandatory prior to exam entry. Hand sanitizing agent will be provided for students in the exam room.
- Students shall maintain a 2 meter separation from other students and ICETRA staff members at all times.
- Students in theoretical knowledge exams are required to wear a face mask in the premises of the Icelandic Transport Authority at all times. Face masks shall cover both a person's mouth and nose.
- Bathroom breaks should be kept to a minimum. The use of hand sanitizers is mandatory before entering and exiting the bathrooms.
- Students showing Covid19 symptoms should contact a health care clinic and notify ICETRA staff as soon as possible. They are advised to stay at home until advised otherwise.
- Students who have come in contact with an individual infected with Covid19, have been quarantined or are currently in isolation due to infection, are obliged to stay at home. ICETRA should in any case be informed so necessary arrangements can be made with regards to the students' attempt at theoretical exams, if any actions may be needed. In such cases, a quarantine confirmation/certificate or a doctor's note might be requested.

Further items students should be mindful of during the exam period

- Please get acquainted with the allowed examination aids specified in the examination rules.
- All other items or documents are prohibited. Most notably:
 - Coats, jackets, hats, caps, backpacks, purses, bags, pencil cases, etc;
 - Mobile phones, computers, tablet computers and other electronic equipment (including e.g.: smart watches, smart glasses, etc.);
 - Student notes and textbooks.
- Students should exit the exam room straight after the exam is finished.
- Please be mindful of electrical wiring when walking around the exam room and do not walk across table rows.
- When an exam is finished, students will need to sort and return their exam documents (log-in papers, scratch papers and annexes) at a designated spot.
